Jeremiah's very difficult mission, and the hostility he experienced, show a prophet who most identified with the sorrow that God must have felt over the rejection

of His chosen people. *The Second Reading:* The Christian life is compared to a race in which all are called to join, keeping Jesus as a model of faith, perfection and encouragement before us. *The Gospel:* Jesus insists that his disciples show him the loyalty which is due only to God, a loyalty which is higher at times than that owed to family or friends.
