Readings for Today – Sun: 8th Oct: *The First Reading:* Through



his prophet, God reminds his people that they have been yielding sour grapes, rather than the wholesome fruit of love and justice. *The Second Reading:* Paul knows the reality of worry and anxiety. He also knows the antidote: 'Fill your minds with everything that is true, everything that is noble, everything that is good...' *The Gospel:* Just as in the first reading, a vineyard features prominently in the gospel. God expects to find fruit in the lives of his people. We should not lean too heavily on the label 'Christian'. Instead, we should ask where we are bearing fruit.
