efforts. We do not have forever to live a good life, to repent, to turn to God: 'Our time is growing short.' *The Gospel* — 'Jesus went into Galilee.' So often, the gospels name where Jesus is working. This makes the point that the Lord's work is concrete, tangible, local. This is how the Lord wants to work today.
