#### Launch of New Parish Project: A new parish project will be

launched on the weekend of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Feb. in St. Patrick's Parish. The name of it is *St Patrick's One World Project*. The name reflects the fact that we live in a global village. Our aim is to support a young woman from a village in Malawi. She is the youngest of a family of seven. Seeing the struggles of her family she was determined to have an education. Now having completed her primary and secondary education she has secured a third level place. We hope to finance her university education because education is empowerment and the most powerful medium for change. This project fulfils the requirements of the Charities Act and it will have supervision on the ground in Malwai. It is under the direction of *wellsforzoe*, which is a Lucan based charity. The project will be launched on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Feb. at Masses. The following weekend 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Feb. we will have a fundraising collection after all Masses.
