Readings – Sun. 12th May: **The First Reading:** Paul and Barnabas engage in a central pastoral task: they urge people to remain faithful to the grace of God – even in times of difficulty and misunderstanding. **The Second Reading:** The victory of heaven is immense: John sees 'a huge number, impossible to count,' who have been faithful in persecution and hardship. **The Gospel:** The Lord describes his sheep, his followers, as people who listen to his voice. There is no discipleship without attentive listening.
